



CODERDOJO 2019 Student and Parent Agreement

The following rules and consequences are to be agreed to by both students and parents. Ongoing attendance at CoderDojo is dependent upon the signing of this agreement.

CoderDojo rules:

- Handle robots with care.
- CODE not game.
- Focus on your own code project.
- Food and drinks are only consumed outside of the multi-purpose room.
- Walk in the multi-purpose room, being careful with where you step.
- Respect other coders and Teachers/Mentors.
- Follow all teacher instructions.
- Listen when someone is speaking (e.g. Sharing Time).
- Pack up and clean up your area at the end of the session.

Consequences if rules are broken:

- Three verbal warnings – each warning will be communicated to parents via Seqta notice.
- Third notice will result in suspension from attending CoderDojo for two weeks.
- Continuous warnings will result in a student being removed from the CoderDojo roster for the remainder of the year.

This agreement must be signed and returned in order to attend the next CoderDojo session which will be in Week 3 of Term 1, and continuing sessions throughout 2019.
