K-12 Celebrating Champagnat Day – Friday 14 June

Thursday 6 June 2019 is the Feast Day of St Marcellin Champagnat, the founder of the Marist Brothers and of Marist education. To mark this very special day in the life of the International Marist Institute, our K-12 College community will be celebrating Champagnat Day across the College on **Friday 14 June**. As one of 52 Marist schools across Australia, the Feast Day of St Marcellin Champagnat is an opportunity for all members of our College community to gather, give thanks, and to celebrate our shared Marist identity.

On **Friday 14 June**, the Champagnat Day Fete at the **Marcellin Campus** will be raising funds for *Australian Marist Solidarity*. Australian Marist Solidarity (AMS) is the international agency for the aid and development work of the Marist Province of Australia throughout Asia and the Pacific Islands. Australian Marist Solidarity works with the people in this region on a combination of short and long-term development projects. These projects aim to develop and support locally sustained educational opportunities for young people in these regions. All funds raised are directed to the Kuya Center for street children in the Philippines. Our Year 11 students visit Kuya annually as part of their immersion. 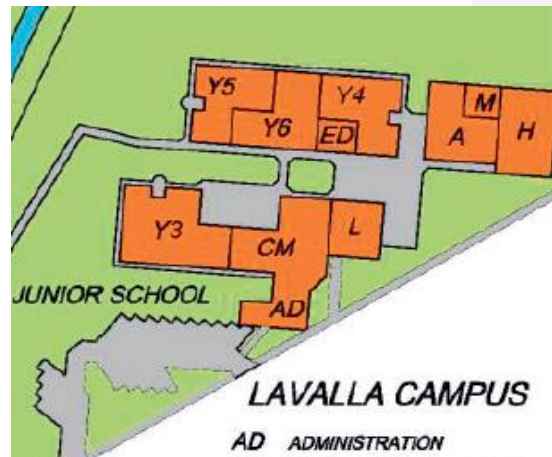
OVERVIEW OF K-12 NEWMAN COLLEGE CHAMPAGNAT DAY ACTIVITIES Friday 14 June

MARIAN AND LAVALLA CAMPUSES

All students from both the Marian & Lavalla Campuses are asked to wear their *Sports Uniform* on this day.

We ask that students from *Marian Campus (K-2)* bring a disposable, biodegradable bag, clearly labelled with the student's name, containing a hat, drink bottle, and morning tea. Marian Campus students should be dropped at Lavalla Campus by their parents/carers at the beginning of the day as follows:

- **Kindy and PP** students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus *Multipurpose Room*, (marked **CM** on map →).
- **Year 1 and Year 2** students are to be taken to the Lavalla Campus from 8.30am where their teachers will supervise them in the *Br Theophane Hall* (marked **H** on map →).
- **Years 3-6** students will arrive as usual at the Lavalla Campus.



Marian and Lavalla Campus Student Lunches

All K-6 students are able to order their sausage sizzle lunch via *Flexischools*. This will be the only ordering available on Friday 14 June. If your child is not ordering lunch they will need to bring it from home. Flexischools ordering will close at 3.00pm on Friday 7 June. Please ensure that orders are completed by this date. Late orders are unable to be accommodated.
