2. Capital Development Update - Tom Wagner

Tender was awarded to Badge Construction. Appointed on the back of a strong tender (consisting of a number of key review elements, not only financial). Badge has done a significant amount of work in Government and Marist schools. Will take possession of the site in 2-3 weeks.

Over the next few weeks critical planning process to take place. i.e. temporary second entrance into S Block, temporary toilet blocks outside Uniform Store.

Recognition there needs to be flexibility on student flow and transit time to get to and from classes.

Significant earthworks commencing on the bridge tomorrow. Estimated completion in 1 week. Minor upgrades to the maintenance sheds too.

Upgrades to Lavalla Campus playground / nature play scheduled to occur over the Christmas School Holidays.

Traffic flow management under consideration. In the future master plan. Currently working with an engineer with respect to short term and long-term plans.

3. CEWA School Cyclic Review – Lisa Fogliani

The CEWA School Cyclic Review process occurs once in a five-year period and contributes to meeting the requirements of the System Agreement with the Western Australian Government as part of school re-registrations in Western Australia.

Newman College will be going through this process during Week 3 (Wednesday and Thursday)

Provides an opportunity for a panel of educators, external to the school, to affirm, challenge and report on the improvement journey at the school. Also contributes to the school's re-registration process.

Very timely for Newman. The outcome of this review will contribute to the College's Strategic Plan 2020-2022.
