APPLYING FOR VET / TAFE COURSES FOR 2021

What is a VET qualification?

A VET qualification (also known as a TAFE qualification) is a great opportunity to get a head start on your career. Choosing a VET pathway means you can make school more interesting and relevant to you while beginning your career with recognised qualifications.

VET qualifications are the perfect introduction into the world of work. You will learn practical skills in Year 11 and 12 while gaining an insight into the needs of the workplace. You will attend training (away from school) one or two days a week and for the rest of the week participate in your normal school program.

Success in your VET qualification can lead to immediate employment by graduating with a nationally accredited qualification, or you will have a head start in other nationally recognised qualifications.

How do I apply?

- 1. Apply for and obtain a Unique Student Identifier (USI) at https://www.usi.gov.au/your-usi/create-usi
- 2. Find your desired course using the VET Provider List below.
- Enrol yourself in your desired course using the website listed. If you have difficulty, see the College VET Coordinator (Mr MacNeill).
 Students must have made an attempt to enrol themselves before seeking assistance.
- 4. Enrolments close **at the end of August**. The VET Coordinator will notify students of the outcome of their application.

Other information

- VET Certificates are available to **non-ATAR Pathway students only.**
- Most Certificate courses commence in Year 11 and continue for two years. A small number of one-year courses are available to commence in Year 12.
- VET Certificates are chosen in addition to the student's 6 school-based subjects.
- VET Certificates are usually studied one day per week. Students will be given permission to be absent from school in order to undertake their VET studies.
- Fees can vary widely depending on the course and provider chosen.
- Newman College will reimburse families the cost of a VET Certificate, up to a limit of \$1,000 per qualification. Reimbursement is paid upon successful completion of the qualification.
