



2021 Fees & Charges

Acceptance Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$1,000 (Secondary) and \$500 (Primary) is payable on acceptance of enrolment for all children.

Withdrawal

It is a condition of enrolment that one full term's notice of withdrawal of a student is given in writing, or a full term's fee will be charged.

Account Payment

One annual account is issued per family in late January. A payment plan must be selected by all families to ensure that all fees are paid in full by the end of the academic year.

Family Discount

Family discount applies to the number of students undertaking schooling at the same time. The discount is applied in order of age, with the eldest student receiving the lowest discount. The discount does NOT apply to Pre-Kindy students or students obtaining Health Care Card concessions. The discount is applied as a percentage of the Tuition Fee (only) as per the below table:

1st Child	Full Fee
2nd Child	10%
3rd Child	30%
4 or more Children	40% Discount for each Child

*Child must be 3 to participate in the program. Rates are individualised based on the number of classes following the student reaching the required age.

Capital Levy

A compulsory Capital Levy of **\$1,100** per annum is charged per family. Families with a Pre-Kindy student **ONLY** are excluded.

Financial Assistance

A fee discount scheme exists for holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, certain Pensioner Concession Cards and Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Card. Applications upon enquiry (excludes Pre-Kindy students).

Secondary Assistance Scheme

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for holders of the above named eligible cards. Holders may request an application form. Conditions apply.

Optional Programs

Music Tuition:
