Parents are welcome to attend the carnival and we request that you sit in the designated spectator area on the western side of the Marcellin oval and only access the assigned visitor toilets.

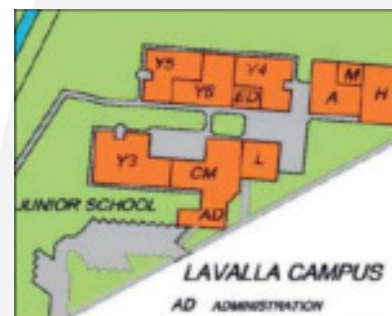
Coffee Van

Student Information

Students must be at the Lavalla campus by 8.45am. Please ensure students are in the correct locations (see below) so the roles can be taken. Students will then move across to the Marcellin oval as a group.

- **Pre-Primary** students must be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus Multipurpose Room (*marked CM on map*).
- **Year 1 and Year 2** students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus, Br Theophane Hall (*marked H on map*).
- **Lavalla** students please move straight to your classrooms.
- Students will need to wear their faction shirt and bring their sports bag containing a water bottle, sunscreen, school hat, snacks, and lunch.
- Lunch orders **ONLY** (no recess) will be available from the Flexischool ordering system on a limited menu.

Collection of Students

LAVALLA ONLY INFORMATION

Pre-carnival events

High Jump (Years 4 to 6) and 400m (Years 5 and 6) will be run prior to the carnival day.

Age Championship Points (Years 3 to 6 only)

Championship points are allocated to the top 8 boys and girls in each age group on completion of the following heats and field events; 80/100m, 200m, 400m (year 5 and 6 only), Hurdles, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Turbo-Jav and High Jump.

All running events are set up as heats rather than divisions. We have endeavored to place runners in an appropriate heats based on time trials or past carnival results. All runners have equal opportunity to qualify for Champion Boy and Girl, regardless of which heat they are placed in. The electronically recorded times will determine the points for Champion Boy and Girl.

Points are allocated as follows:
