Student Responsibilities

Students who are unwell are not to present at the examination. Students who are unwell must contact the College on the day of the examination and obtain a medical certificate to support their absence.

Marist Auditorium

The auditorium is for exclusive use of Year 12 students writing their examinations, during the examination period.

This exclusive use extends to bathrooms. Auditorium bathrooms will be cleaned during the day (between the morning and the afternoon examination) for the examination period

College staff and invigilators have been informed of the following conditions

- 3. Observing a high standard of personal care and hygiene
- 4. Observing social distancing, with adults, whilst on campus
