Please note:

Due to new laws, from the 5th of October 2021 Winthrop is no longer allowed to sell insurance or add on warranty at the time you purchase the device. Winthrop will send you an email **5 days after** you place your order with a link to purchase insurance or add on warranty if you wish to do so. You **must opt-in on the checkout page** to receive the email.

AppleCare+

Highly recommended, for if the device gets dropped/damaged accidentally. Apple can cover two incidents for replacement per year with a \$65 excess fee. Warranty extended to 2 years.

Loss or Damage

Newman College takes no responsibility for stolen, lost, or damaged devices, including lost or corrupted data on those devices. In the event of loss, theft or damage, students must immediately report the incident to the ICT Department, PCG teacher and parents. If any problems occur with the device or with the iPad operating system (including damages), the College ICT Department will diagnose the issue. If the device requires repair or replacement, the ICT Department will advise the appropriate course of action. On certain occasions where a device requires repair or replacement, a loan device may be provided to the student by the College as an interim measure.

The College strongly recommends all parents purchase a tough case to protect their child's device from damage.

The College strongly recommends all parents take out theft and accidental damage insurance coverage on devices for the duration of their use. Parents may be able to add their child's BYOD device as a portable item to their home contents insurance.

Newman College strongly recommends all parents purchase an extended warranty when purchasing a device.
