


2026 Fees & Charges

Acceptance Fee

To secure the enrolment for your children you are required to pay an acceptance fee of \$750 per family for primary enrolment and \$1,500 per family for secondary enrolment. This fee is credited against your school fees when your children commence at the College. Should you choose to withdraw your children at any stage after payment, this fee is non-refundable.

Capital Levy

Each family is subject to a mandatory Capital Levy of \$1,800 annually, except those with only a Pre-Kindergarten student, who are exempt from this charge.

Account Payment

A single yearly statement is issued to each family during the latter part of January. All families must choose a payment plan to guarantee the full settlement of all fees by the conclusion of the academic year.

Withdrawal

As a prerequisite for registration, we require written notification of a student's withdrawal at least one full term in advance. Failure to do so will result in the payment of the full term's fee.

Financial Assistance

A fee discount scheme exists for holders of a Centrelink Health Care Card, certain Pensioner Concession Cards and Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Cards. Applications upon enquiry (excludes Pre-Kindergarten students)

Secondary Assistance Scheme

The State Education Department offers a Secondary Assistance Scheme for holders of the above named eligible cards. Holders may request an application form. Conditions apply.

Family Discount

Family discount applies to the number of students undertaking schooling at Newman College at the same time. The discount is applied in order of age, with the eldest student receiving the lowest discount. The discount does not apply to Pre-Kindergarten students or students obtaining a Health Care Card concessions. The discount is applied as a percentage of the Tuition Fee (only) as per the below table:

1st Child	Full Fee
2nd Child	10%
3rd Child	30%
4 or more Children	40% Discount for each Child

Program Specific Charges

Optional Programs

Music Tuition:

From 2026, music tuition fees will be added to your school fees account. The charge(s) will cover the full year's music-related costs, including lesson fees and, where applicable, instrument hire. By consolidating these charges with school fees, we aim to provide a more streamlined and convenient payment process for families. A Music Diary will be provided at no charge.

If you intend to discontinue music lessons, kindly provide one term's notice.

Tours - Sporting, Cultural, Academic:

To be eligible to participate in any college tours, students must have made full payment of college fees or established an authorised payment plan. Only after fulfilling this requirement can a student apply for enrolment in these programs.
