



## Marist X Selection

### Preface

The Marist Basketball X is selected at the completion of each Marist Carnival. It has been designed to acknowledge excellence by recognizing the best ten boys and girl players of the carnival. Each selected team member will be presented with a medal and certificate to symbolise their outstanding play. Although some effort should be made to include a representative from a wide range of competing schools, precedence should be given to selecting the best ten players.

All positions in this team will be determined by the criteria outlined in this document and discussed in the Marist Basketball X selection meeting held at the end of day two matches.

Coaches of each of the respective teams will attend this meeting and may be provided with statistical information of all players to inform their decisions.

The team should be composed of a balanced mix of guards, forwards, and centres to reflect an optimal lineup. The selection panel, based on their discussion and the provided statistical data, can determine the final composition. The selection panel should also consider the spirit in which each player conducted himself in the games they participated in.

## Selection Criteria for Marist X Team

### 1. Sporting Excellence

- Demonstrates strong ball-handling, shooting, passing, and defensive skills and game awareness.
- Ability to finish under pressure and execute plays effectively.
- Understanding of game strategies, spacing, and movement off the ball.
- Consistently contributes to team success with effort and performance.

### 2. Respect for Opposition Players and Teams

- Competes fairly and follows the rules with good sportsmanship.
- Treats opponents, officials, and teammates with respect.

### 3. Humility in Victory

- Celebrates success respectfully without arrogance.
- Acknowledges the efforts of teammates and opponents.
