

## Prerequisites for Year 11 Courses, 2027

Please note the following before making your selections:

1. All students must select at least 1 'List B' course.
2. Students taking the ATAR Pathway must select at least 5 ATAR courses.
3. Students taking the General Pathway may select 1-2 ATAR courses if eligible, but can only select from those ATAR courses marked with a ✱.
4. For all ATAR courses, it is a prerequisite that students have met the minimum Literacy and Numeracy standard for WACE, via Year 9 NAPLAN or Year 10 OLNA.
5. Students who have not met the WACE Numeracy standard must select Mathematics General or Mathematics Foundation.
