The Feast Day of St Marcellin Champagnat is an opportunity to gather with other Marist schools across Australia and throughout the world to give thanks, and to celebrate our shared Marist identity.

Fete Information

The Fete will be cashless, please read the following information relevant to your child's year group.

Kindergarten to Year 5

All students in Kindergarten to Year 5 will be required to purchase a \$10 ticket for the day. The ticket will include a donut and Fete activities. Students will receive a wrist band that permits them access to the activities and therefore will not need to purchase tokens. The Kindergarten to Year 5 tickets can be purchased through [FlexiSchools](#).

Year 6

To promote independence and familiarity with the Marcellin campus, students in Year 6 will pre-purchase tokens, and use their tokens to purchase their food and activities on the day. A list of the proposed Fete stalls has been included below. Tokens can be purchased through [FlexSchools](#). Tokens must be purchased no later than **Tuesday 16 June at 8.00pm**. Tokens will be distributed to students in class before the Fete. Unused tokens are not refundable.

Recess and Lunch

The Canteen will be open for ordering to Primary students only, students can opt to bring their own recess and lunch or order. Year 6 students may choose to use their tokens to purchase food at the Fete, however we recommend students to order through the canteen as usual as food stalls can be busy.

Uniform Requirements

Students are to wear their Sports Uniform with their Guild Shirt. They will need to bring their hat to be worn during the Fete activities. Year 12s are permitted to wear their Leavers Jackets.

Times of Day

Students will attend PCG as normal for roll call. During Periods 1 and 2, they will participate in Mass followed by the Champagnat Awards presentation. They will then return to PCG to prepare for the Fete, followed by the Fete itself and afternoon activities. The day will conclude with our inaugural *Rhythm of Guilds* event, where students from each guild will compete against one another.

Fete Information

The Fete will be cashless, and students will need to pre-purchase tokens. Tokens can be purchased through [FlexSchools](#). Tokens must be purchased no later than **Tuesday 16 June at 8.00pm**. A list of Fete stalls and pricing has been included below.

Tokens will be distributed to students in PCG on Thursday 18 June. Unused tokens are not refundable.

A list of the proposed Fete stalls has been included below. Students will be asked to either make a small donation towards their stall or contribute through cooking or other preparation in the lead-up to the event. Students will also be involved in setting up, running, and packing down their stall on the day.

Food items at the stalls will range from approximately \$2 to \$10, while activities will cost approximately \$1 to \$5. A suggested amount of \$15–\$20 is recommended to allow students to purchase food and drinks and participate in a range of activities throughout the Fete.
