Sportsmanship/Respect for Others

The carnival is a Faction Carnival which fosters team spirit through participation, encouragement, having fun and fair play. Staff acting as officials on the day will be working hard to ensure the judging of events is accurate and fair.

Parents/Spectators

Parents and spectators are welcome to attend the carnival and must sit in the designated spectator area on the western side of the Marcellin oval. We have specific assigned toilets for parent/spectator use and ask you to refrain from using other College facilities.

A coffee van will be available near the Auditorium.

Student Information

- Y3 Y6 students should be dropped as usual and make their way to their classroom where attendance will be taken. They will then move across to the Marcellin oval as a group. The carnival will commence at 9.00am.
- Pre-Primary students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers in the Lavalla Campus Library.
- Y1 and Y2 students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus in the Br Theophane Hall.
- Students need to wear their faction shirt and bring their sports bag containing a water bottle, sunscreen, school hat, snacks, and lunch.
- Lunch orders ONLY (no recess) will be available from the Flexischools ordering system as usual.

Collection of Students

- Students are required to stay for the entire day. Students can only leave the carnival early
 if the College has received notification before the day. This notification should be provided

- Pre-primary students will conclude the carnival at 12.45pm. Students can be collected by their parents. If you cannot collect your child, they will be taken back to the Lavalla campus under teacher supervision for the remainder of the day.
- Students will be dismissed from the Marcellin oval at 3.00pm. Any remaining Marian students will be taken to the Br Theophane Hall at Lavalla Campus for collection and Lavalla students will be dismissed to the car park.

Age Championship Points

Championship points are allocated to the top 8 boys and girls in each age group on completion of the following heats and field events: 80/100m, 200m, 400m (Year 5 and 6 only), Hurdles, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Turbo-Jav and High Jump (Year 4-6).

All running events are set up as heats not divisions. We have endeavored to place runners in an appropriate heat based on time trials or past carnival results. All runners have equal opportunity to qualify for Champion Boy and Girl regardless of which heat they are placed in.

Students have been trialing for the field events during class or Unit Sport this term. They will be notified of their events via Seesaw.
