## MARIAN AND LAVALLA CAMPUSES

### Kindy

### Year 1 and Year 2

Students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus *Br Theophane Hall* (marked **LH** on map).

### Years 3-6

Students will arrive as usual at the Lavalla Campus and go to their normal classroom.

## Lapathon

Children will bring home their Sponsor Sheets for the Lapathon which will be used to record funds raised. Please return Sponsor Sheets by **Monday 7 August** to the classroom teacher. They will be signed off at the end of the Lapathon

## What to Bring
