HOMEWORK CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT 2022

- Homework Club is a place where students can gain assistance from Teachers and Tutors. It is a place where they can collaborate with their peers, study, complete homework and unfinished classwork.
- Students must be respectful and considerate towards Teachers, Tutors, their peers and the environment itself when attending Homework Club. There are designated areas for certain types of study including quiet collaboration and completely silent work (where only the use of headphones is permitted). Please refer to the maps and signs in the JHN Hub which indicate the specific areas available.
- Students are welcome to bring snacks and water to Homework Club, but these must be quickly consumed outside (near the Learning Hub doors/steps). All litter must be disposed of responsibly in the bins provided.
- Students must sign in and sign out via the electronic system every time they attend Homework Club. Students must sign in just after the bell has gone at 3:15pm (unless they have a legitimate reason to be in another part of the school and they are being supervised by an appropriate person). If this is not the case, students must leave the school premises.
- Digital devices – such as laptops and phones – are permitted only if they assist with homework and study. Attending Homework Club to play games is not permitted.
- If a student needs to leave the Learning Hub during Homework Club hours they must get permission from the Supervisor and confirm when they have returned.
- Uniform expectations still apply during Homework Club hours.
