



## Newman College Homework Club - Code of Conduct 2023

- Homework Club is a place where students can gain assistance from teachers and tutors. It
  is a place where they can collaborate with their peers, study, complete homework and
  unfinished classwork.
- Students must be respectful and considerate towards teachers, tutors, their peers and the
  environment when attending. There are designated areas for certain types of study,
  including quiet collaboration and completely silent work. Please refer to the maps and
  signs in the JHN Hub which indicate the specific areas available.
- Students must come prepared to work at Homework Club. This means that they must have
  all their homework and study materials available and be ready to start working once they
  enter the JHN Hub. Students who do not come prepared and are disruptive will have
  the privilege of attending Homework Club withdrawn.
- Students must sign in and sign via the electronic system every time they attend Homework Club. Students must sign in just after the bell has gone at 3:15pm (unless they have a legitimate reason to be in another part of the school, and they are being supervised by an appropriate person). If this is not the case, they must leave the school premises.
- If a student needs to leave the JHN Hub during Homework Club time they must receive permission from the Supervisor and confirm when they have returned.
- Students are welcome to bring snacks and water to Homework Club, however, these must be consumed inside the JHN Hub on the theatre steps near the Cafe. All litter must be disposed of responsibly in the bins provided.
- Digital Devices (such as laptops and phones) are permitted only if they assist with homework and study. Attending Homework Club to play games is not permitted.
- Uniform expectations still apply during Homework Club hours.
