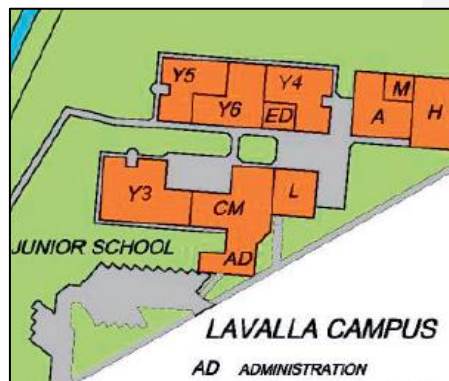
Newman College Assumption Day Activities - 11 August

MARIAN AND LAVALLA CAMPUSES

All students K-6 will celebrate on Thursday 11 August at the Lavalla Campus.

Marian Campus students should be dropped at Lavalla Campus by their parents/guardians from 8.30am.

- **Kindy and Pre-Primary** students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus *Multipurpose Room*, (marked **CM** on map).
- **Year 1 and Year 2** students are to be taken by their parents to meet their teachers at the Lavalla Campus *Br Theophane Hall* (marked **H** on map).
- **Years 3-6** students will arrive as usual at the Lavalla Campus.



What to Bring

Students K-6 are to bring their school bag, clearly labelled with the student's name, containing a hat and a drink bottle, recess and lunch.

Students are required to bring morning tea and lunch. Parents can still place recess and lunch orders on Flexischools.

Uniform Requirements

All students are invited to wear the jersey of their favourite sports team or alternatively, the Newman sports uniform with their Guild polo shirt. Students in Kindy should dress in the clothes they would normally wear for school.

Collection of Students

To avoid traffic issues at the end of the day, parents/guardians are asked to collect students from the following venues:

- 3.15pm Year 3 to 6 students can be collected from the Lavalla Campus drive-through as usual
