RE: Subject selection for Year 11, 2024

Throughout Term 2, Year 10 students will be exploring the offerings of subjects for Year 11, 2024. This is an important process for Year 10 students as it has significant implications for their studies in Year 11 and 12, and for post-school destinations. This letter provides an outline of the timeline for Year 11 subject selection, and to detail the support offered by the College.

Year 10 students will engage in guided research and reflection focused on their strengths, interests, and goals for the future throughout Term 2. Towards the end of Term 2, students will be asked to draw on this research to select their subjects for Year 11, 2024.

TIMELINE FOR YEAR 11, 2024 SUBJECT SELECTION

Term 1, Week 8	Year 10 students provided with the necessary prerequisites for Year 11 subjects, to allow them to set goals for their Semester 1 report. For reference, these can be located at: https://www.newman.wa.edu.au/wp-content/uploads/2024-Year-11-Prerequisites.pdf
Term 2, Week 2	Year 10 students to receive their Subject Selection Research Booklets, and the Senior School Pathways Information Booklet, at an Assembly. These resources are included with this letter. Leaders of Learning to speak to Year 10 students about subjects available in Year 11. Year 12 students to speak to the Year 10 students to provide a student perspective on subjects and pathways. Term 2, Week 7-8	Year 10 Examinations.
Term 2, Week 9	Wednesday 21 June: 5.00pm: Year 10 Careers Expo 5.45pm: Year 10 Parent Information Evening Compulsory events for all Year 10 students
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Term 2, Week 10	Year 10 Semester 1 reports available to students and families. Students should have completed their Subject Selection Research Booklets by this time, including their draft Year 11 subject choices.
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Term 3, Week 1	Students and parents / guardians will meet individually with their subject selection mentor to review and approve subject selections for 2024.
Term 3, Week 5	Information about enrolling in Work Experience and TAFE / VET Certificates for 2024 will be provided to students and families.

Each Year 10 student will be assigned a mentor teacher to support them through the subject selection process. This staff member will be the initial point of contact for students and families and will be able to provide support and pastoral care as students make their decisions. The mentor will also approve the student's final subject selections and provide guidance on appropriate subject and pathway choices.
