## YEAR 7 2022



- 1. Establish good habits and routines (e.g. sleep, nutrition, self-care)
- 2. Introduce and encourage different organisational tools (e.g. study timetable, diary/planner, brain breaks, etc.)
- 3. Provide the right supplies (e.g. items from booklist)
- 4. Review timetable when it becomes available
- 5. Discuss what will be different about high school (e.g. locker use, different classrooms/teachers, larger year group, etc.)
- 6. Encouragement to make new friends and participate in social aspects of high school (e.g. sports, Game Changers, music, etc.)
- 7. Normalise feeling nervous (everyone feeling the same) and that it may be challenging but that they will have lots of support!










